BILL MACKLEM RECOGNIZED FOR FUNDING OVER \$1 BILLION IN MORTGAGES

The Canadian Mortgage Brokers Association – British Columbia (CMBA-BC) is pleased to announce that Bill Macklem of Dominion Macklem Mortgages has been inducted into the MB Funding Roll of Honour at the \$1 Billion Tier.

Macklem, surrounded by his peers and family, was conferred with this prestigious honour last week during a ceremony held at the Redwoods Golf Course in Langley, BC.

“I would like to express how humbling this is in regard to the number of clients and friends we have assisted over the past 30 years,” said Macklem. “I am amazed I have reached such a high amount of mortgages throughout my career. It is not possible to reach this level without the support of my lending team, our lender partners, all our clients, our realtor partners, and of course, the ongoing support of my wife and family.”

Bill Macklem has a passion for helping people with their money, whether it is for their personal or business financing. His early work involved selling the precious black earth of his home province of Manitoba. Yes, Bill sold bags of dirt across Western Canada. He then moved to Alberta and became a mortgage broker with Combined Mortgage and Intergroup Mortgages while also teaching at the University of Alberta.

In 1994, he moved to BC and joined when the Re/Max Western Canada mortgage broker program in the lower mainland. After 10 years with RE/MAX, he was asked to join Dominion Lending Centres in 2007, establishing the Dominion Macklem Mortgages franchise, with offices in the interior and the lower mainland. He has ranked in the top 20 brokers in Canada since 2007.

The MB Funding Roll of Honour was launched in 2017 by CMBA-BC in recognition of the outstanding achievements of Member Mortgage Brokers. This accolade reflects independently audited volumes of mortgages originated over the course of the Member’s career. To date, only five members, including Macklem, have been recognized for surpassing the \$1 Billion threshold. Previous inductees include Karen Gibbard, Feisal Panjwani, Rob Regan-Pollock and Garth Ellis.
